



Talking Points on Proposal 2

Thank you for your willingness to help us defeat Proposal 2. We know that if Proposal 2 passes, we will NEVER have fair and free elections in the State of Michigan ever again. Together as long as we stick to the talking points below, we will defeat this horrific proposal.

- Please ensure you are using the verbiage Proposal 2. Do not use the words “Promote the Vote.” Even though these are the sponsors of the proposal, those words will be nowhere on the ballot and we want to ensure voters are not confused when they go into the polling booth.
- This petition is going to put in the Constitution that you will never have to show an ID to vote, ever again.
- It will allow any private individual (Mark Zuckerberg, George Soros, Betsy DeVos, Donald Trump, etc.) to donate any amount to a local clerk to run their elections.
- Following the passage of this proposal, incarcerated felons COULD have the opportunity to vote in our elections. This would make it so Jackson State Prison will be the largest precinct in the State.

Our polling shows that these top three issues is how we defeat this radical proposal. We know there is a lot more in here that will ruin the sanctity of our elections, but as long as we have everyone stick to the above points, we will be successful on November 8th.

For informational purposes, below is the language that will appear on the ballot this fall:

A proposal to amend the state constitution to add provisions regarding elections

This proposed constitutional amendment would:

- Recognize fundamental right to vote without harassing conduct;*
- Require military or overseas ballots be counted if postmarked by election day;*
- Provide voter right to verify identity with photo ID or signed statement;*
- Provide voter right to single application to vote absentee in all elections;*
- Require state-funded absentee-ballot drop boxes, and postage for absentee applications and ballots;*
- Provide that only election officials may conduct post-election audits;*
- Require nine days of early in-person voting;*
- Allow donations to fund elections, which must be disclosed;*
- Require canvass boards certify election results based only on the official records of votes cast.*
